On-Site Field Trips:

Traditional tours are back! We will discuss on a case-by-case basis ways in which we can make it happen while meeting both the school's and our own COVID safety policies. Also, NEW in 2022, each group will have the opportunity during their tour to experience a short interactive one-room school lesson in the FWSQ's historic garrison school!

Outdoor Experiences:

If you would like to visit in person but an indoor tour will not fit your needs, both sites are now able to offer tours and presentations which explore the stories of the historic grounds in the safety of the outdoors (weather permitting). Hikes and picnic areas are available to further enhance your visit.

Online Tours:

As was the case last spring, both sites are still prepared to offer live Zoom tours directly to your classrooms. Whether your students sign on individually or as a classroom, we offer a full virtual interactive exploration of our sites.

- Traditional field trips or on-site outdoor experiences at the Historic Indian Agency House cost \$3 per student (teachers and all chaperones free). Student admission to the Fort Winnebago Surgeons Quarters is provided FREE this year thanks to a generous grant from the Lenz Charitable Trust, and the first four teachers/chaperones of each group are also free. Please be sure to schedule early as funds are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Self-guided hikes on a signage-based interpretive trail are free at the Historic Indian Agency House.
- Virtual tours cost a flat fee of \$15 for the entire class at the Historic Indian Agency House and are free at the Fort Winnebago Surgeons Quarters thanks to the Lenz Charitable Trust.
- History on the Move involves a \$3 per student charge plus mileage.
